AUGUST IS CHILD SAFETY AWARENESS MONTH! It's Back to School Time!

School is starting up again so please be mindful to:SLOW DOWN:

AWARE: Do not pass school buses when they are stopped. Children's safety is the most important priority!

THE ARROWHEAD ESTATES DO NOT DO LIST

DO NOT SPEED or allow your family or friends to SPEED in Arrowhead. The HOA gets complaints from residents regarding folks who REGULARLY SPEED on our neighborhood streets. The posted SPEED LIMIT IN ARROWHEAD IS 25 MPH ALL DAY AND ALL NIGHT EVERY DAY AND EVERY NIGHT!

DO NOT ALLOW yourself or your lawn service to blow grass clippings/leaves in the street in front of your home and leave them there or even worse blow them into the storm sewers directly! PLEASE SWEEP UP YOUR YARD DEBRIS AND PROPERLY DISPOSE OF IT IN YOUR TUESDAY YARD WASTE PICK-UP! Remember – only rain down the drain!

DO NOT walk or allow a member of your family to walk your dog and allow it to defecate on the grass alongside our neighborhood sidewalks or on our GREEN AREAS and fail to bag it and dispose of it properly in YOUR GARBAGE CAN. This IRRESPONSIBLE BEHAVIOR leaves unsightly and smelly feces that may result in someone getting it on their shoes; moreover, it can spread canine viruses and diseases to other dogs.

DO NOT allow your dog to move freely OFF LEASH in the neighborhood. Off leash dogs can display unexpected behavior when another dog or a person becomes of interest to them WHILE THEY ARE OFF LEASH AND THEREFORE, UNCONTROLLABLE. Folks have been extremely frightened by charging, barking, snarling dogs while their owner has allowed them to be off leash and uncontrollable. These dogs have injured and killed other dogs while off leash in Arrowhead. DO THE RIGHT THING...KEEP YOUR DOG ON THE LEASH!

DO NOT FORGET your parking manners. Please use common safety practices. Our roads are narrow, so when parking, do not block the roadway, driveways, fire hydrants, nor intersection corners. Please only park on paved streets or driveways and be mindful of parking across the street from other parked vehicles. For safety reasons, please make sure that emergency operators can get through.

DO NOT START A PROJECT WITHOUT ARCHITECTUAL BOARD APPROVAL. Please go to

our website to see ARTICLE VII, Sections 1 – 6 of our Declarations and Covenants for detailed information. You can also access the ARB application and other helpful information regarding the most common projects. The ARB is comprised of fellow neighbors who volunteer their time to review all applications. Please be sure to have your application submitted in advance of your project so that it can be reviewed timely. DO NOT put bulk waste by the side of the street without contacting the County or WastePro <u>first</u>. Some items are too large to fit into your garbage

can, but WastePro can help you



dispose of them responsibly. They offer on-demand bulk waste pickup services for various household items such as: major appliances, furniture and mattresses. Here is the link for Lake County: <u>https://www.lakecountyfl.gov/trash-recycling</u> (352-343-3776) or call WastePro at 352-366-0352 to schedule your pick-up.

"All trash, garbage or other refuse shall be placed for pickup not earlier than the evening preceding pickup, and any and all containers for such trash, garbage or refuse shall be returned no later than the evening of pickup **TO THEIR NORMAL**, **HIDDEN LOCATION**. No trash, garbage or other waste material or refuse shall be placed or stored on any part of the Community except in covered or sealed sanitary containers. All such sanitary containers must be stored within each dwelling..... or placed within an enclosure or concealed by means of a screening wall approved by the ARB." Regarding the County Road (CR) 455 bridge and roundabout construction, outside our community.... This work is part of the widening of Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 from SR 50/Clermont to Hancock Road/Minneola.

CR 455 will meet the entrance to Arrowhead Estates at a flatter elevation than it is currently. The trail will meet the

entrance to our community the same as it did prior to construction. Construction ends at the two existing drainage structures in the entrance's driveway, approximately 40 feet from the edge of the roadway.



This project is not building

an additional entrance to

CR 455. The entrance to

our community remains

the same, with the only exception being the flatter

elevation, mentioned

above.



The current construction schedule anticipates the front entrance and the trail reopening in six to eight months. It is important to

note, the schedule may change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.
